**Campaign Rules**

- No Candidate or Student may publicly campaign for office, on or through any platform, online or in person, prior to **Saturday, September 12, 2020**.
- No Candidate shall give, offer, or promise to any student or student organization any specific benefit in order to influence the votes of that student or members of that organization;
- No candidate or representative shall misrepresent any material fact in campaign materials or in campaigning of any form;
- No campaigning of any sort (includes placement of materials or use of whiteboards) is permitted within classrooms or the Legal Information Center. **This extends to zoom classrooms as well.**
