Any student intending to run for one of the above Representative positions must submit electronically to uflawsba@gmail.com: (1) This signed form (digital signatures are acceptable); (2) A short **statement no more than 500 words** detailing their platform; (3) A campaign photo. *Statement and photos submitted will be published to the student body through the SBA website.*

The deadline to submit this form is Friday, February 12, 2021 at 5:00 PM.

Campaign Rules

- No Candidate or Student may publicly campaign for office, on or through any platform, online or in person, prior to **Friday, February 12, 2021**.
- No Candidate shall give, offer, or promise to any student or student organization any specific benefit in order to influence the votes of that student or members of that organization;
- No candidate or representative shall misrepresent any material fact in campaign materials or in campaigning of any form;
- No campaigning of any sort (includes placement of materials or use of whiteboards) is permitted within classrooms or the Legal Information Center. **This extends to zoom classrooms as well.**
